- Adults that are not currently in the Early Childhood field, but would like to earn a credential in Early Childhood Education
- Adults that are already in the Early Childhood field but would like to earn the credentials needed to qualify for their position, or advance in their career
- Preference given to those that are from populations such as minorities, have a disability, have low income, or are a non-typical early childhood worker.

'FAQ:

- What if I finish my coursework, but don't complete the CDA credential? Participants will be awarded funds based on the chart on the back page. If you finish the coursework, you keep the funds and do not have to re-pay them, but will not be awarded the second amount of funds.
- Do I have to provide any documentation? For each award level, you will have to provide your transcripts or copy of the certificate or degree to receive funds

- How do the funds get paid? The funds will be paid directly to you as a stipend. You can use the funds to cover any expenses you have paid out of pocket or to cover the cost of being gone from work to get your work experience hours completed. You will receive tax information at the end of the year for these funds.
- Do I have to go to a specific school / program? You are welcome to choose your own program or school. The funds can be used to pay for whatever expenses you incur. There is a list of possible programs on our website.
- How many people will receive funding? There
 are a limited number of awards available and will
 be based on the programs in which the accepted
 participants are enrolled. Apply now to secure
